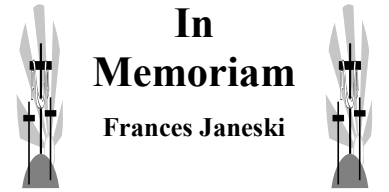
Fellow Hibernians,
